The 'Responsible Person' must nominate a sufficient number of persons to assist with evacuation procedures. Research has shown that the use of nominated individuals will reduce the time taken to evacuate a building. The fire marshal/warden course also includes fire extinguisher training, which can be optional.

who should attend?

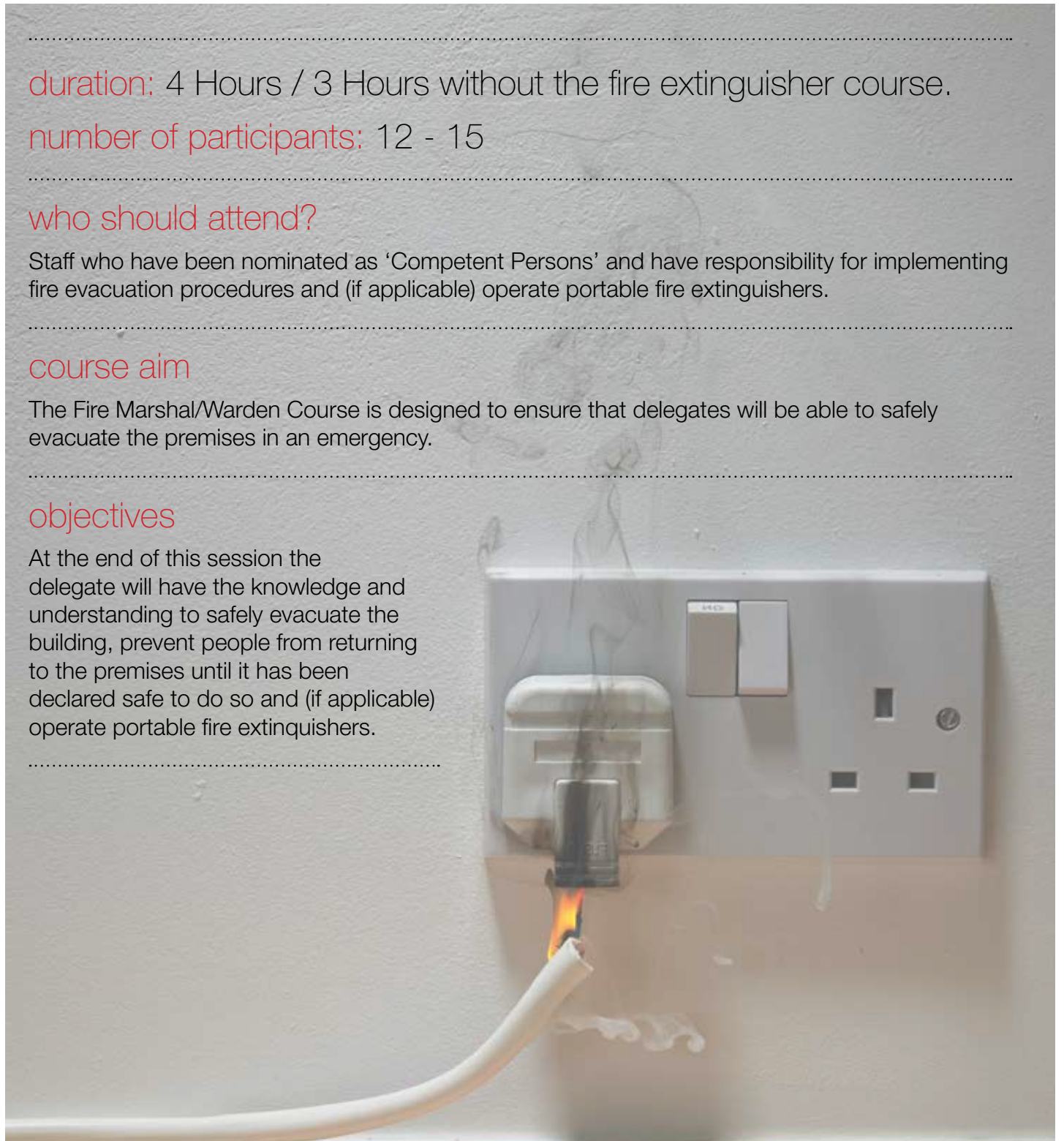
Staff who have been nominated as 'Competent Persons' and have responsibility for implementing fire evacuation procedures and (if applicable) operate portable fire extinguishers.

course aim

The Fire Marshal/Warden Course is designed to ensure that delegates will be able to safely evacuate the premises in an emergency.

objectives

At the end of this session the delegate will have the knowledge and understanding to safely evacuate the building, prevent people from returning to the premises until it has been declared safe to do so and (if applicable) operate portable fire extinguishers.
